


TALK to UP

Kidzone caught up with creator and author of *The Deep*, Tom Taylor.

Tom Taylor

KZ: *The Deep* is back for Season 4! What can viewers expect?

TOM: More adventure! More fun! More pirates! A mystery bigger than anything we've seen before involving Ant and Fontaine's grandparents. And Jeffrey the fish will steal every scene as usual.

KZ: What's new with the Nekton family in Season 4? Has Ant dreamt up any new ways to annoy Fontaine?

TOM: Of course. But Ant has really graduated from annoying his sister (though she provided invaluable practice) and he's far more keen to annoy people who would treat the ocean poorly ... and pirates like Mad Madeline, of course.

KZ: Do you hear from fans of *The Deep* from around the globe?

TOM: We do. It's wonderful. We see fan art, and hear from lots of people who love the Nekton family – from parents and younger audiences. We hear from grandparents who watch it with their grandkids and parents who say their kids watch it on repeat every day.

KZ: What inspired you to create the original *The Deep* graphic novel series?

TOM: I had a number of inspirations. I REALLY wanted to create a good comic for my own kids. Something exciting and funny that parents would want to read WITH their children. And I've always been fascinated with the ocean. It's huge. It's mostly unexplored and we know so little about it. It's a great mystery full of life, from tiny plankton to giant leviathans. A family who explore that final frontier right here at home is very exciting.

KZ: Do you have a favourite vehicle from *The Deep*?

TOM: My favourite vehicle is probably

Season four of *The Deep* is about to arrive on our screens and a startling revelation takes the amazing Nekton family off on a whole new adventure!

With every clue they find, the Nektons discover they have even more questions about where on earth their grandparents might be. Along the way, they encounter more amazing Monumentals and learn that these huge creatures are greatly misunderstood. They also discover a huge secret that the Bajau Laut 'sea nomads' of the South China Sea are hiding.

But it's the seemingly simple rescue of a single polar bear that will provide the family's biggest challenge when Ant and Fontaine bring it aboard the Aronnax!

As for their long-lost family? The clues eventually point Ant and Fontaine to the location of the most incredible Monumental they've ever seen. Tom: I have. I've been lucky enough to snorkel with my family in a lagoon full of sharks and stingrays. And my family and I went scuba diving in Fiji, including my youngest who was probably 8 or 9 when he had his first scuba adventure and fed fish on the bottom of the ocean.

KZ: What's the best part of working to make a hit TV series like *The Deep*?

Tom: It's what we hear from fans. It's the people this show makes happy. That's definitely the best part.

KZ: What is your favourite ocean creature?

Tom: The colossal squid. It's amazing.

KZ: What do you hope the audience learns from *The Deep* about caring for our oceans?

Tom: I hope that the Nektons show how important our oceans and our world are. How important it is to preserve natural treasures like the Great Barrier Reef. And how hard we should work to combat climate change, and keep the oceans full of life and full of incredible mysteries forever.
